

Banner Commission for the SO Festival 2015

Participants young and old in East Lindsey worked with banner maker Pauline Taylor to make flags and bunting in preparation for the SO festival in 2015.

Pupils from Year 1 in Skegness Infant Academy, made amazing multicoloured bunting using an abstract technique with silk paint, while Year 2 designed and coloured individual flags using imagery of things they love in Skegness, ranging from the clock tower to underwater creatures, to best friends.

“SO what do you Wish Flags” have been made by people of all ages ranging from young children in Edward Richardson Primary in Tetford, to teenagers in Louth and in Mablethorpe, and elders in Skegness Day Centre.

Pauline was commissioned to create 50 large hand painted silky banners which feature some elements of the community work, while focusing on different parts of the region including Horncastle, Louth, Alford, Woodhall Spa, Mablethorpe, Spilsby and Skegness.

The banners have been exhibited in each of the areas and then are shown together at the SO festival in Skegness each year.
